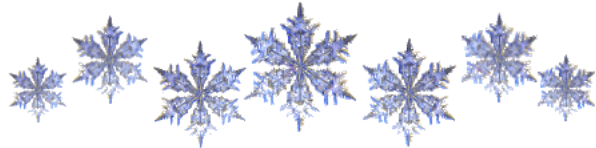

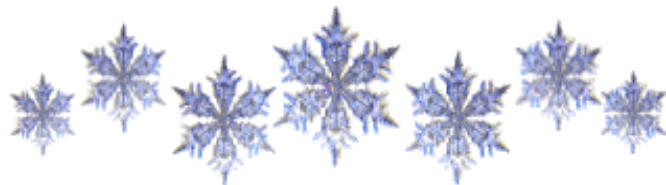
OFFICE NEWS

Recipe Corner

Broccoli Cheese Soup

Bring to boil: 4 cups water and 4 chicken bouillon cubes

Add: 2 12oz bags chopped broccoli
3 cups O'Brien hash browns

Bring back to boil and boil for 5 minutes. Turn on medium heat and stir in 2 cans cream of chicken soup and 1 lb. box of Velveeta cheese cut in chunks, (I use about 1 1/2 lbs.). Stir until dissolved.
