Jordan called the meeting to order at 3:35 p.m. Minutes of the April 16 meeting were approved.

#### Open Session

Nine members signed in for the open session. Jordan welcomed them and called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

#### Gina gave the office report.

There were 28 statements of credit and 32 statements of charges. There were 43 defaults, one attorney referral, four installation/alteration permits submitted and approved, two exterminations, three animal violations, two vehicle violations, one towing and one noise violation.

Two two-bedroom units are currently on the market.

Betsy gave the managing agent's report for Linville Management Services, Inc.

Two applications have been approved.

Two final statements have been completed.

Processed in accounts payable for April were \$173,213.

Financial reports were mailed to the board on May 7.

#### Kevin presented the maintenance report.

In April, there were 173 requests for service received and 123 completed. There have been one move-in and two move-outs. Six rehabs are underway.

Palmer Lawn Professionals mowed once and applied crabgrass and fertilizer treatments and weed killer.

A new slide has been ordered for the playground behind building #44 and will be installed in June.
