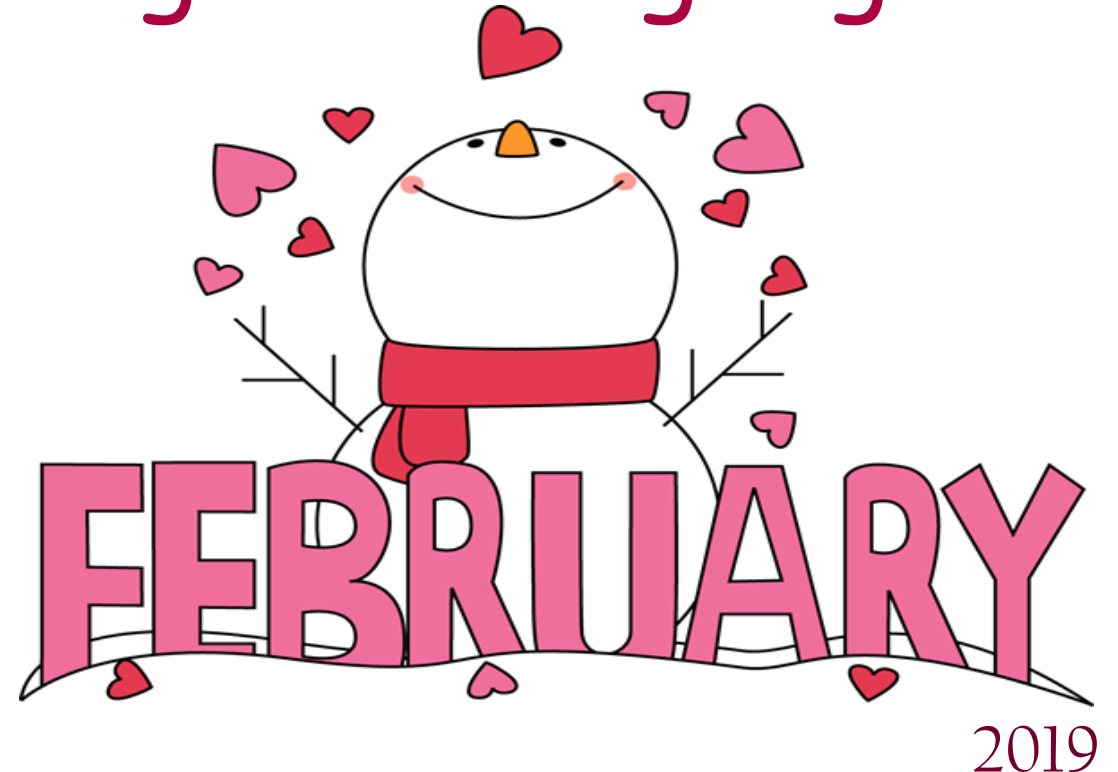

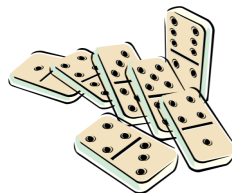
Office News

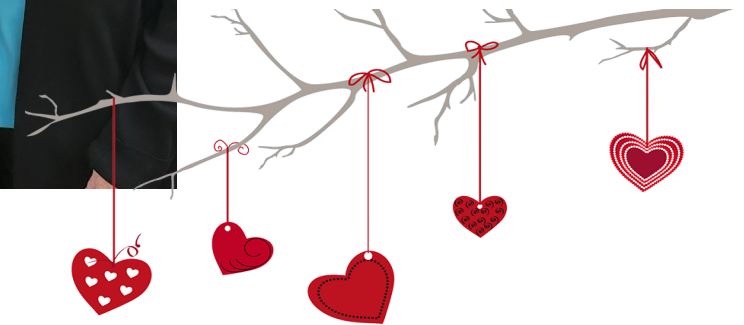

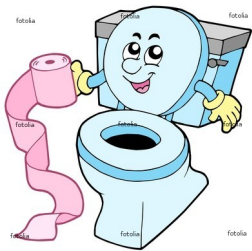
PLEASE DO NOT PUT SHOP TOWELS OR PAPER TOWELS IN TOILET STOOLS
