Edna Carver won the door prize drawing and gave it to her daughter, Sharon Conn.


The open session ended at 6:20 p.m. and the meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m.

Ring Door Bells may be a great Christmas gift this year but remember you must have an installation permit to install.


