Maintenance summary

Kevin reviewed the maintenance report.

In November, 74 service requests were received and 124 completed. In December, 95 service requests were received and 58 completed. There were five moveouts, one move-in and one transfer.

Palmer Lawn Professionals completed leaf clean-up and removal and finished gutter cleaning on December 10.

Six rehabs are underway.

Trapped and removed were 166 squirrels at a cost of \$9,630.

Three two-bedroom units are available. Two three-bedroom units are available.


